THE MID PALATE IS SHOWING POWERFUL TANNINS AND FINISHING WITH NOTES OF SAGE AND CLOVES. THERE IS A LASTING FINISH OF CRUSHED ROCKS AND BLUEBERRIES. THE WINE IS SHOWING VERY WELL RIGHT NOW AND HAS A GREAT AGING POTENTIAL."
