"BEAUTIFUL NOSE OF CASSIS, LICORICE WITH RED FRUIT AND A HINT OF MENTHOL. MID-PALATE HAS ATTRACTIVE SILKY TANNINS COMBINED WITH GOOD ACIDITY AND A BED OF RIPE CRANBERRIES, RED FRUIT AND BLACKBERRIES. COMPLIMENTING THE FRUIT, YOU WILL FIND ELEGANT TOUCHES OF CIGAR BOX, DARK CHOCOLATE AND SWEET OAK. THIS WINE IS SUPPLE AND READY FOR DRINKING."
